Food donations

The following are some suggestions for food donations. *Please use this as a guideline only.*

We can use almost anything and often find it advantageous to let people donate according to their wishes and as they are able.

- Individual puddings (especially vanilla and chocolate) and applesauce
- Cans of broth
- Creamed soup
- Canned fruits and vegetables
- Oatmeal, Cream of Wheat and Malt-O-Meal
- Pancake mix/Bisquick
- Pancake syrup
- Coffee
- Cake mixes, brownie mixes, and canned frosting
- Flour
- Sugar, regular, powdered, and brown
- Mayo
- Fruit juice (shelf stable)
- Marshmallows
- Stove Top (or other brands) Dressing mix
- Butter
- Chocolate Chips
