RIDE FOR \$1 WITH THE TRANIST ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

The Transit Assistance Program (TAP) makes public transit more affordable for lower income transit riders. Customers can take a bus or train for just \$1 per ride – even during rush hour – with a 2 ½ hour transfer. TAP works on a Go-To card, with benefits like paperless transfers and balance protection. Riders have access to the \$1 fare for a full year.

Signing up is easy! Apply online at www.metrotransit.org/tap-enrollment-form or in person at a service center. Be sure to bring you ID and a document that shows that you are eligible like a Free/Reduced Lunch letter, EBT card or Medical Assistance card.
