Lent begins soon: Ash Wednesday is March 5.

To support your Lenten journey, this mailing includes the *Little Black Book*. The booklet contains scripture, reflection and prayer for each day of Lent. (Note that the book actually starts on Sunday, March 2.) I invite you to spend six minutes a day with these books. It's a St. Matt's tradition, a way to help us deepen our appreciation of Lent.
